## Mounds View Physics Fair

Come to the Mounds View High School gym tonight (Monday, March 8) for the 13th annual Mounds View Physics Fair! This is the largest event of its kind in the country.

More than 300 seniors will be presenting their physics projects for judging by 23 engineers from the community. The students have been working outside the school day for the past five weeks in groups of four to design, assemble, and perfect their component interactions.

We provide them with kits to build four components: a tracked vehicle, a hovercraft, a catapult, and a Capsela vehicle. The students assemble and modify these components, and others of their choosing, and create triggering mechanisms so that each component starts the next in a Rube Goldberg-like chain reaction. Then each group must come up with a final trigger to start the next groups project.

Tonight, each group is judged individually by the engineers from 6:30 to 7:30 pm, then each class sets up and attempts their chain reaction from 7:30 to 8:30 pm. It's a lot of fun for all ages and everyone is invited. Guests are welcome anytime from 6:30 to 8:00 pm.
