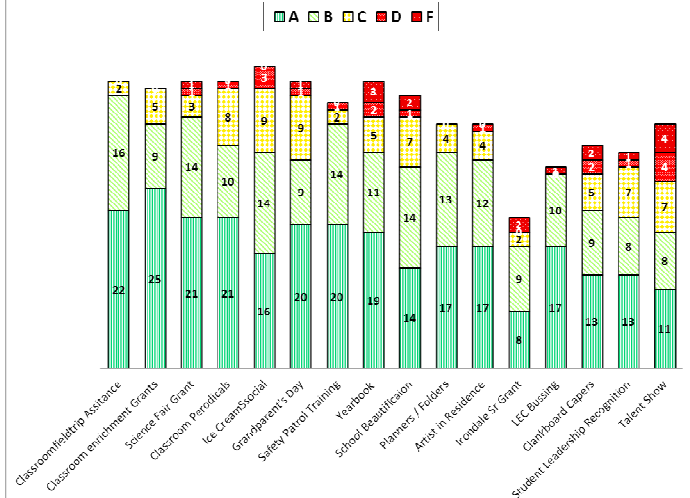

**IMPACT – Future- additional opportunities provide relevant resources to our Sunnyside community.**

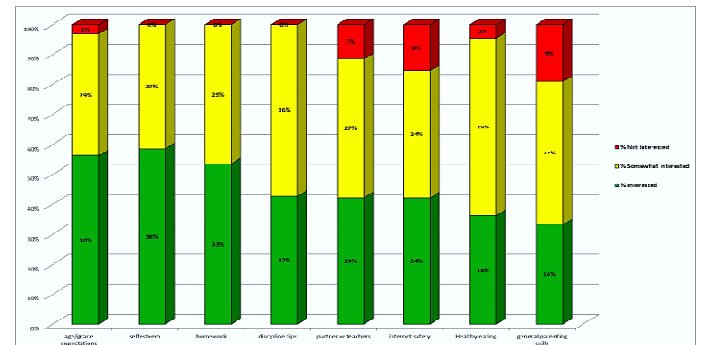
In an effort to be a more **relevant resource for families and community**, we asked for your input on different topics to gauge interest for future guest speakers, workshops, and events, and social outings.
