
Do not mark or label the following:

- 
- 12 small glue sticks
 - 1 8 box markers (classic colors)
 - 2 boxes 8 count Crayola crayons— not jumbo

Do label or mark the following with your child's name:

- 1 medium t-shirt for painting
- 1 large book/tote bag, at least 12" x 14", easy to open
- \$12 **cash — not check** — for classroom activities and additional educational supplies


Do not mark or label the following:

- 
- 24 #2 pencils, sharpened if possible for year (not Pentech or RoseArt)
 - 4 Expo low-odor dry erase markers
 - 1 large box soft facial tissues, unscented
 - 12 glue sticks (not RoseArt or Target brands)

Do mark or label the following with your child's name:

- \$12 **cash — not check** — for classroom activities fund and additional educational supplies
- 1 set of Crayola wide markers, washable, any colors
- 1 sturdy two pocket folder
- 1 set of 8 watercolor paints (preferably not Roseart)
- 1 Children's scissors with all metal cutting edge
- 1 48 ct basic color crayons (not RoseArt)
- 1 pencil box--**no larger** than 6x9
- 1 large backpack school bag 12" x 14" minimum (**easy** to open and close)
- 1 composition notebook, wide ruled, *sewn binding* — *not spiral bound*
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener, with built-in shavings "catcher"
- 1 1 inch, 3-ring binder, any color
- 2 wide-ruled spiral notebook
- 1 pack colored pencils
- 1 clean sock to use as a whiteboard eraser
- 1 clipboard (about 9 x 12 inches)

Do not mark or label the following:

- 60 #2 pencils, **sharpened**
 - 2 large boxes soft facial tissues, unscented
 - 1 Elmer's white glue
 - 10 Elmer's white glue sticks
 - 2 low-odor dry erase markers, wide tip

Do mark or label the following with your child's name:

- 1 one box Crayola crayons (24 count only)
- 1 box Crayola Markers - Classic Colors
- 1 box Crayola Markers - your choice of colors
- 1 set of Crayola watercolors
- 1 pack Crayola colored pencils
- 2 green or blue ink felt tip correcting pens

Specialist Supply List

Grades one, two, three, four and five: Students need a 9" x 12" sketchbook or drawing pad for their Art Specialist class.

Grade three, four & five: one Science notebook & folder.

Grade four: Students will need to purchase a high quality recorder, music book and notebook for \$10, available through the Vocal Music Specialist in September.

All Grades: Tennis shoes (**no black soles please**) and wear comfortable clothing on P.E. day.

If you are able, please purchase "extra" school supplies and leave them at the PTA table at Meet Your Teacher. They'll be used throughout the year for students in need. Thanks!

Individual teachers may have additional supplies needed and will give you that list when school begins.

Do label or mark all items with your child's name except pencils, tissues, and black fine tip markers:

- 48 #2 pencils, **sharpened**, if possible for year; not RoseArt brand
- 2 red marking pens
- 1 scissors, Fiskars preferred
- 1 black/white speckled cover, 100 sheet, 9.75 x 7.5, wide ruled, *sewn binding* — *not spiral bound*, composition notebook
- 2 Black (fine) felt tip markers (not Sharpies)
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 set of colored wide markers, washable
- 1 pack colored pencils
- 1 yellow highlighter
- 1 set water color paints, not RoseArt brand
- 1 12" ruler — with both centimeters & inches
- 1 supplies box, sturdy plastic, no larger than 6 x 9
- 1 container of Clorox wipes
- 1 clean sock for dry erase lapboards
- 2 large box soft facial tissue, unscented
- 1 book/tote/back pack 12" x 14" minimum
- 3 wide line metal spiral notebooks, non-perforated pages
- 3 pocket folders
- 2 plain pink eraser
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener w/catcher
- 1 TI-15 calculator (*see note after 5th grade*)
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 dry erase markers, low-odor

Do label or mark all items with your child's name. Please **do not** label folders and notebooks with subject and class — only the student's name.

- 48 #2 pencils, *sharpened*
- 1 scissors
- 1 box of crayons OR set of colored markers OR package colored pencils, washable, not permanent
- 1 glue stick
- 1 ruler — metric & inches
- 1 pencil box, sturdy plastic, small size – NOT large
- 2 large boxes soft facial tissues, unscented
- 1 backpack/book/tote bag 12" x 14" minimum
- 5 college (narrow) lined metal spiral notebooks:
 - 1 each: yellow, green, red, blue, black or purple
- 5 pocket folders:
 - 1 each: yellow, green, red, blue, black or purple
- 3 blue or black ball point pens
- 1 black fine-tipped marker (Sharpie)
- 1 highlighter
- 1 compass protractor — clear, plain
- 1 calculator (*see below for more info-TI15 preferred*)
- 1 package loose leaf wide-line paper
- 1 package of 5 dry erase markers, any color
- 1 old clean sock or eraser
- 1 1 inch 3-ring binder
- \$10 **cash** — **not check** — for classroom activities and additional supplies such as Time For Kids magazine

- 1 container cleaning wipes

TI-15 calculators will be available at VHES (cost + tax) through a supplier of educational calculators and teacher materials. TI-15 calculators are not available in retail stores. Please do not purchase any other model. The cost will be between \$14.00-15.00. Order/payment forms will be sent home with grades three, four and five students in September. PTA volunteers will engrave your child's name on the unit. Your child will then receive the calculator from the teacher.
